We must be informed of any medical conditions or general problems, so we ask if you could please state this on the application form.

TASK DESCRIPTION& RISK ASSESSMENT

All participant must be willing to complete the following activities, and have some knowledge of how to do so

Grooming horses and ponies Tacking up Leading ponies and horses Mucking/skipping out stables Sweeping yards General housekeeping tasks Feeding and watering Changing horse's rugs Possible turning out & catching horses Tying up of horses & ponies Washing off horses & ponies Cleaning tack Some possible light manual handling Assisting of customers Wearing of personal protective clothing Possible leading and helping with in the lesson

Risks identified

Risk of being bitten, kicked or trampled by horses, trapping fingers in stable doors when grooming, feeding, watering & washing of horses. Risk of tripping, slipping or falling when leading horses.

Possible risk of injury when carrying out any manual tasks, should any incorrect manual handling techniques be used.

Possible risk of injury should personal protective clothing not be worn correctly. Possible dusty environments. Inhalers should be kept at the yard if required.

Remedial Action Required

Extreme care and caution to be exercised when undertaking any required tasks as a helper. Strict adherence to company procedures and all instructions given, to enable all tasks to be carried out in a safe manner, wherever it is reasonably practicable, at all times, and wearing all required personal protective clothing.

No running or shouting on the yard

No entering prohibited areas

No smoking

No swearing

No entering stables unless authorised

No feeding horses or carrying sweets around the yard

Ask before feeding tip bits to horses

No jewellery

Suitable clothing and footwear to be worn

Gloves and hats must be worn when leading

No personal stereos

No chewing gum

Sign in and out of the yard when entering and leaving

Break times and lunch times as advised by the yard manager on the day, to be taken in the function room (NOT STAFF ROOM). This area must be tidied, and kept clean/clear for functions/parties.

Any problems/accidents/injuries to be reported to staff

Members do not have permission to enter the area behind desk in the office, and are not authorised to look through personal information within this area (diary/booking forms/etc).

Please respect the privacy of other members/staff/riders at Barrow Hall Stables when taking photographs. Any published material online/social media must have the consent of any parties included.

Sharing of rider names/ride lists/personal information regarding the running of Barrow Hall Stables is forbidden.
